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CALL FOR ABSTRACTS (oral & poster presentations)

Please be sure to read and adhere to the following instructions. Abstracts that do not meet these requirements will not be considered. These instructions pertain to both oral and poster abstract submissions. Abstracts must be typed, single spaced 12 point, Arial font in MS Word. Please provide abstract in hard copy as well as an electronic copy ie CD, floppy disc or email (for publication in conference proceedings booklet). If more than one abstract is submitted a separate electronic copy must be supplied with each hard copy. Please mark each disc with authors name and title of abstract. Facsimile abstracts will not be accepted.

Every submission must contain the following:

- a) cover page
- b) abstract
- c) bibliography (optional)

COVER PAGE

- a) Abstract title
- b) Type of presentation: oral or poster
- c) Please consider/do not consider my oral abstract submission for poster presentation
- d) Please circle category that most reflects the abstract: Clinical Research, Case study, Informational/Educational report or Laboratory research
- e) Corresponding authors name, address, phone number, fax, email
- f) List of authors and their facilities in the order in which they are to appear in the published abstract.
- g) Has this information been previously published or presented Yes or No (please circle)
- h) If 'Yes' please explain
- i) If selected the following person will present this abstract at the 2008 WCANSW conference (Name)

ABSTRACT

1. Abstracts essentially answer four questions:
 2. a) What was the problem?
 3. b) How did the author(s) solve it?
 4. c) What was discovered?
 5. d) What can be learned from the experience?
6. The body of the abstract should not exceed 200 words with a maximum of ten references.
7. A 50 word CV is required from each presenter to enable the chairman to introduce you should your abstract be accepted.
